rue verb	Meaning : bitterly regret (something one has done or allowed to happen) and wish it undone. Synonyms : deplore, lament, bemoan, bewail
rampage verb	Meaning : (especially of a large group of people) move through a place in a violent and uncontrollable manner. Synonyms : storm, charge, tear; rave
asset noun	Meaning : a useful or valuable thing or person. Synonyms : benefit, advantage, blessing,

diligence <i>noun</i>	Meaning : careful and persistent work or effort. Synonyms : conscientiousness, assiduousness, assiduity
encompass <i>verb</i>	Meaning : surround and have or hold within. Synonyms : surround, enclose, ring, encircle, circumscribe, skirt
indictment <i>noun</i>	Meaning : a formal charge or accusation of a serious crime. Synonyms : charge, accusation, arraignment, citation, summons
scrutiny <i>noun</i>	Meaning : critical observation or examination. Synonyms : inspection, survey, scan, study, perusal
